

# Emergency Response Times - Hazard Class 3

Reporting period: 01 April to 30 June 2022



Hazard Class 3 covers all urban areas that are not included in Hazard Class 2 and includes predominantly residential occupancies and small industries.

CFA has service delivery standards, which specify a response time target for a brigade to attend an emergency incident. The service delivery standard (response time) for Hazard Class 3 is 10 minutes.
