

Post-visit teacher led session:

Fire safety for your home

Background

Students can do simple things to keep safe from burns and fire. In addition, students can discuss fire safety with their parents/guardians to motivate more substantial fire preparedness activities at home.

Suggested teaching time

30 minutes

Objectives

To consolidate the personal and home fire safety learnings of CFA's visit.

Materials needed

- **Worksheet 26: Fire safety connect**
- **Support material 4: Meet Captain Koala and friends**
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloured pencils

Lesson outline

1. Talking about fire safety at home

30 minutes

- Ask students what they learnt when CFA visited. Prompt them with questions such as 'What do we do if we see a box of matches on the bench?', 'What would we do if the room filled with smoke?', 'What would you do if your clothing caught on fire?'
- Provide each student with a copy of **Worksheet 26: Fire safety connect**. Have students cut out the images and the fire safety messages. Ensure that their messages and images are paired up correctly and pasted on a second sheet of paper.
- Use **Support material 4: Meet Captain Koala and friends** to remind students of the tasks CFA undertakes.
