

CUT OUT THE FIRE HAZARDS

The items shown below are either **flammable** or **non-flammable**.

Flammable means that an object is capable of catching fire and burning rapidly.

Non-flammable means that an object is not able to burn easily.

Colour in the images, cut them out and group them into 'flammable' and 'non-flammable'. On a piece of coloured paper, draw two columns and write the following headings at the top of each, (1) 'flammable, and (2) 'non-flammable. Then decide which illustration goes where and glue them in position.
