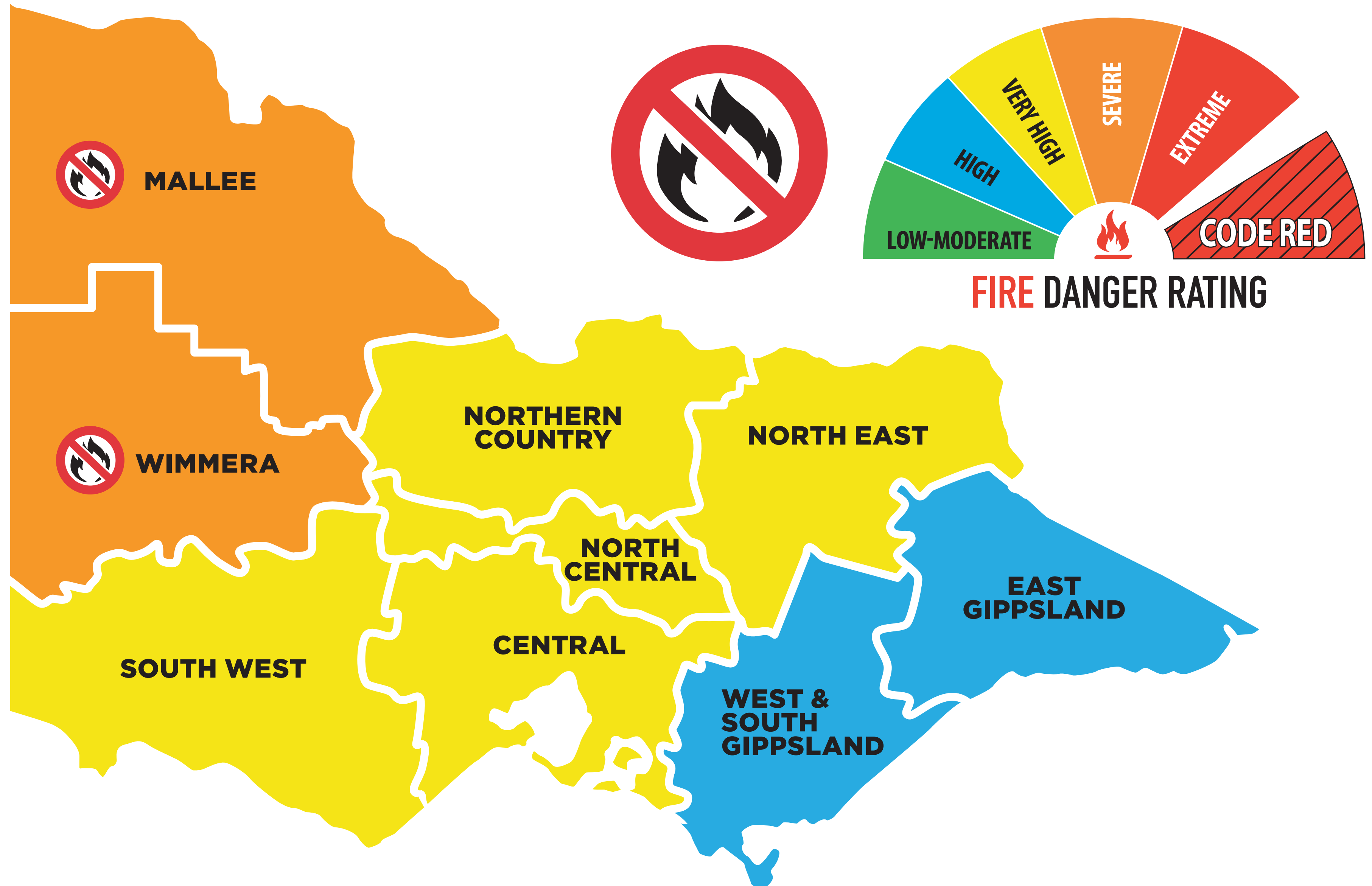


KNOW YOUR DISTRICT



➤ KEY POINTS

- Victoria is divided into 9 Fire Weather Districts. Total Fire Bans and Fire Danger Ratings are declared by District and you must know which District you live in.
- Total Fire Bans are declared by CFA on days when fires are likely to spread rapidly and be difficult to control. On days of Total Fire Ban there are legal restrictions in force to reduce the likelihood of fires starting.
- The Fire Danger Rating predicts how a fire would behave if started, including how difficult it would be to put out. The higher the rating, the more dangerous the conditions. The rating is your trigger to act, so to stay safe you need to stay aware of the Fire Danger Rating in your District.
