



## ADVICE TO FIRE PREVENTION OFFICERS ISSUING A PERMIT TO BURN TO BRIGADES

- 1 Insert the name and address of the officer in charge of the brigade and the name of the brigade.
- 2 The following must be specified:
  - i The type of material to be burnt. (The permit may specify any material).*
  - ii A commencing and finishing date indicating the period during which the permit is current.*
  - iii The name of the person(s) or organisation(s) which owns, occupies or manages the land to be burnt.*
  - iv The address or a description of the land on which the burning is to be done.*
  - v The width of fire breaks, being a minimum width of 1.5 metres.*
- 3 In paragraph (4) of the permit, the first alternative will generally be used. The second alternative is to be used for “heap” burns or for stony country. Delete the inapplicable part of the paragraph.
- 4 Enter any further conditions considered necessary in paragraph (8) of the permit.
- 5 It is recommended that permits be issued for the minimum practicable time.
- 6 It is important that all insertions and deletions are completed before the permit is signed.
- 7 Any person who has the power to issue a permit to burn also has the power to cancel or vary it.
