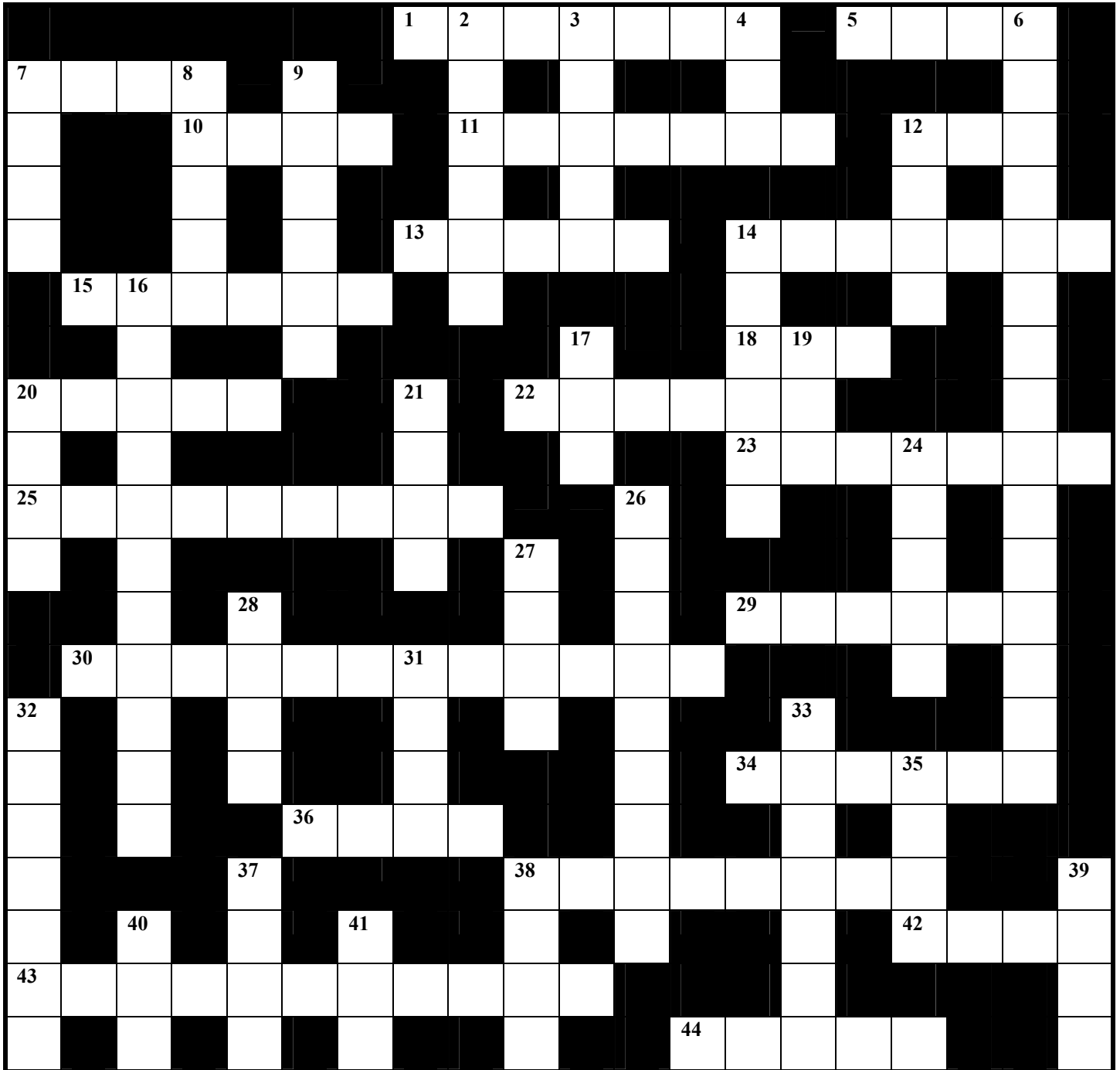


# COMMUNITY FIREGUARD CROSSWORD



## **ACROSS**
