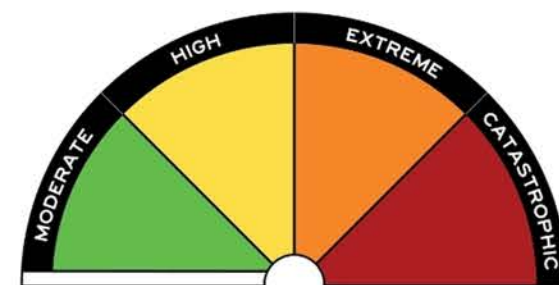


The Fire Planner is an easy-to-use

Actions you can do to
prepare your property

- ☐ Create a fire plan and consider
what your back-up plan is
- ☐ Ensure your insurance is
sufficient and current
- ☐ Keep grass areas well trimmed
and watered
- ☐ Trim shrubs and clear fine fuels
from around your home
- ☐ Create a plan for pets
and livestock
- ☐ Download the VicEmergency
app and create a watch zone
- ☐ Pack an emergency kit with
important documents, photos,
medications, money and clothes
so you're ready to leave early
