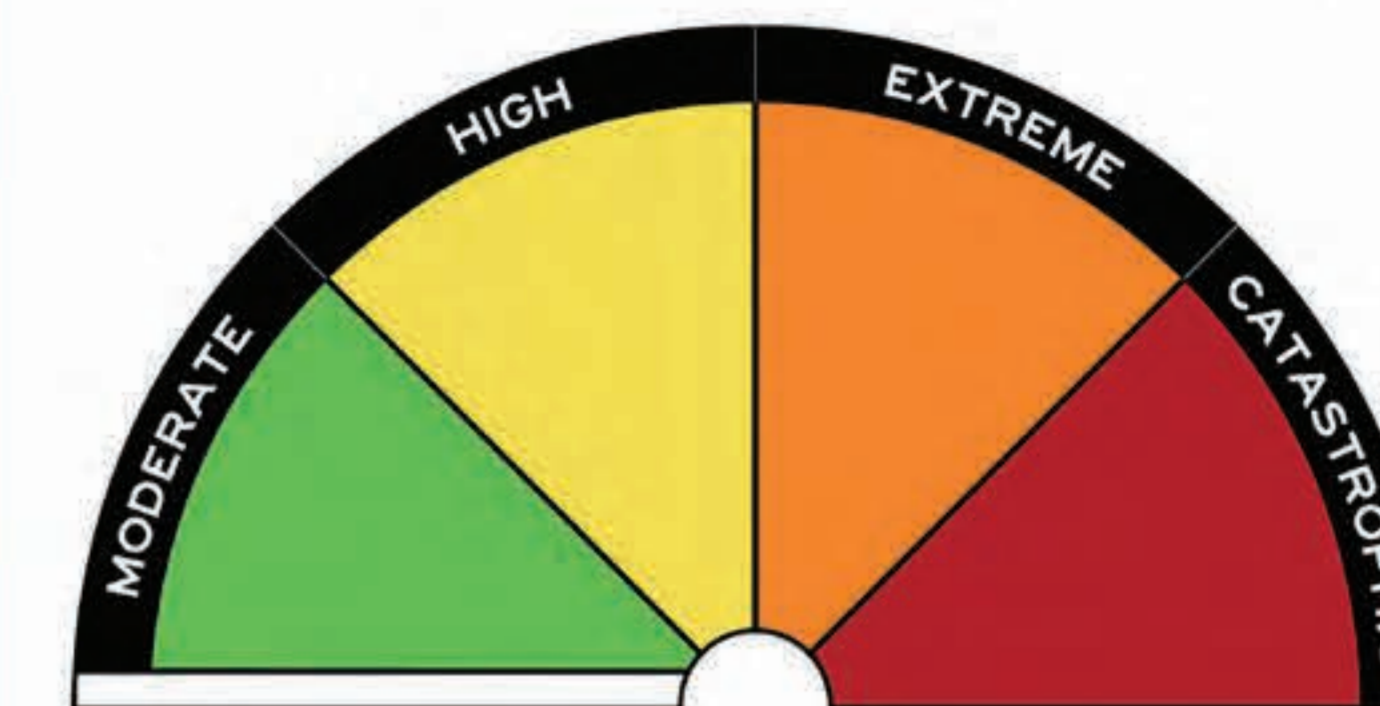


The Fire Planner is an easy-to-use online tool designed to help you get ready in the event of fire risk. Having a fire plan can make all the difference when it comes to staying safe.

**Actions you can do to prepare your property**

- Create a fire plan and consider what your back-up plan is
- Ensure your insurance is sufficient and current
- Keep grass areas well trimmed and watered
- Trim shrubs and clear fine fuels from around your home
- Create a plan for pets and livestock
- Download the VicEmergency app and create a watch zone
- Pack an emergency kit with important documents, photos, medications, money and clothes so you're ready to leave early

When the Fire Danger Rating is Extreme or Catastrophic, leaving the night before or early in the morning is the safest option for your survival.
